

RESOLUTION NO. 09-193, SERIES 2009

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAVIS APPROVING THE TEN-YEAR PLAN ON HOMELESSNESS, *ONE AT A TIME: ENDING AND PREVENTING HOMELESSNESS FOR YOLO COUNTY RESIDENTS* AND COMMITTING TO SUPPORT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PLAN

WHEREAS, the 2009 Homeless Census found 491 homeless individuals within Yolo County, 289 of which were unsheltered; and

WHEREAS, the cities and county governments within Yolo County recognize the need for countywide collaboration in providing services for ending and preventing homelessness for Yolo County residents; and

WHEREAS, the cities and county governments have partnered in the Yolo County Homeless Coordination Contract since 1990 and during that same time have supported the Homeless and Poverty Action Committee, always working towards countywide partnership; and

WHEREAS, the Social Services Commission unanimously supported the plan at their November 16, 2009 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the cities and the county have contracted with HomeBase over the past year and have hosted public forums and opportunities for information gathering and input throughout the county in preparation of the 10-Year Plan for Yolo County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Davis that the Ten-Year Plan for Yolo County, *One at a Time: Ending and Preventing Homelessness for Yolo County Residents (2010-2020)* is approved; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City Council commits to supporting the implementation of the plan over the next ten years through partnerships with public agencies, non-profit service organizations, faith-based organizations, rental property owners, and community members throughout Yolo County, subject to the availability of resources and consistency with local planning goals.


