7. Status Reports

Housing Day Follow-up - Jesse Doty was the raffle winner from the event. The prize was a Plasma TV donated by Tandem Properties.

ASUCD Student/Police Relations Sub-Committee – The Meet & Greet with the Police Officers occurred. There were some protestors at the event. The Sub-committee is working on a “Know your Rights” event.

UC Davis West Village project – Sacramento City College is having their groundbreaking ceremony on June 10th, at 10 a.m.

City/Campus Entertainment Partnership - The next event, Music on the Green, is May 22nd at Central Park and will feature the group “Thao with the get down stay down”.

Safe Party Initiative – P. Paulson is working on Fall planning. M. Carmichael stated the UC Davis Police Department will be attending a Safe Party Conference this summer.

2010 Picnic Day – G. Sandy stated a task force was formed to plan changes for the 2011 event. M. Carmichael stated that 60 citations were issued on campus for alcohol related offenses. Ten citations were issued for drunk in public. G. Sandy stated that every hotel in town was booked. It is the 2nd most successful night of the year; commencement being first. S. Vergis asked if UC Davis made requests to bar owners to curb alcohol. G. Sandy stated they do make this request every year and they offer safe beverage practices training. Generally, their requests have been ignored. K. Pope suggested that they hold a meeting with the bar owners and not rely on a form letter to get the message out. He also suggested the bar owners sign a community covenant.

M. Carmichael stated the Whole Earth Festival was a much more subdued event. Whole Earth has a Karma Patrol” that polices many of the issues at the event. More families attended this year’s event. Some citations were issued for alcohol and marijuana possession. He stated it was a good event.

Model Lease Sub-committee – The project is moving slowly. The Apartment Managers are busy trying to get vacancies filled. The sub-committee recommends restarting the project in the Fall.

Renters Education Guide Sub-committee – T. Whitcomb stated all the writers have submitted their drafts. S. Winton suggested the Commission have a working meeting in June to get comments back to Tandem for revisions over the summer.
