B.2 Commission/Staff Comments
Staff:

- The Davis-Woodland Alternative Transportation Corridor Kick-off Meeting was held on February 23. The meeting was well attended (approximately 60 residents, farmers, property owners). Staff received a variety of comments. The meeting summary will be posted on the Yolo County's Web Page. As the next step, the Consultant will propose alternative routes based on the comments received. One or two neighborhood meetings will be held to discuss alternatives. The goal is to have a recommended alternative for the Councils/County Supervisors in summer 2009.
- Old North Davis Neighborhood is holding a workshop on Fifth Street. The workshop is scheduled for Friday, March 6th at 11:30 at the Council's Chamber.

D. Discussion Items

D.1. Request for 20-Minute Parking – C Street at Third Street

Staff presented the background of the information. The business owner at 316 C Street requested that 20-minute parking be established adjacent or near the business to accommodate their customers. Staff collected parking data on C Street. The collected data indicated that parking is typically fully occupied during lunch hour and the rest of the day it is 70% to 90% occupied. 20-minute parking spaces have been installed throughout downtown over the past few years (mostly at the intersections). However, there are no 20-minute spaces on the northeast corner of C and Third Streets. Installing the proposed 20-minute space on Third Street at C Street would accommodate the businesses on this block of Third and C. DDBA Parking Committee and Farmers Market were supportive of staff's recommendation.

Action: Commission approved staff's recommendation, unanimously.
