Unitrans is seeking input on the following concepts being considered to improve on-time performance.
  - J-line options to improve on-time performance
    - “Express” service
    - Eliminate north Sycamore segment
  - P/Q East options to improve on-time performance
    - Run all service via Covell and Alhambra
    - (with extension of L line to cover Wildhorse and Slide Hill/Loyola)
  - P/Q West options to improve on-time performance
    - Run all service via Arlington
    - (with K line revised to run inbound via Arlington-Humboldt-Arthur)**Recommendation:** Discuss concept proposals to help identify future recommendations.
13. **Overview of Route Change Recommendations in Light of School District Revised Boundries, this Effects S and W Lines**  
Unitrans is seeking input on two potential service changes in response to DJUSD request:
  - W-line: Reverse loop via Lillard-Drummond-Cowell (if reduced running time achieved), this requires changes to several bus stops
