- P/Q Express trips running hourly during Regular Service Schedule

The following trips are proposed to operate via Covell between Pole Line and Monarch (only when the "Regular Service" schedule is in effect; all other trips would operate on current route via Pole Line-Loyola-Tulip-Temple-Monarch):
7:00, 8:00, 9:00, 10:00, 11:00, 12:00p, 1:10p, 2:10p, 3:10p, 4:10p, 5:10p, 6:10p.

- Revised M line

The M line will be revised to serve more passengers based on the results of a passenger survey. Most likely route would incorporate Drummond and Cowell then continue inbound via Richards/1st St.
