# Two Men Stabbed in Davis Altercation

On December 21, 2009 at approximately 5:30 PM Davis Police Department Patrol Officers responded to the Sutter Davis Hospital Emergency Room in regards to two victims who were admitted with multiple stab wounds. The victims told Officers that they drove themselves to the hospital after being involved in an altercation with an unknown suspect in downtown Davis.

Further investigation revealed that the victims were involved in a confrontation with a suspect in the area of Third Street near the California Northern Railroad tracks as they were walking in downtown Davis. Both victims stated that an unknown suspect accosted one of the victims, stabbing him multiple times. The second victim was stabbed when he came to the aid of his friend. After the attack, the second victim drove the first victim to the hospital.

The suspect was described as a mixed race Asian male adult, who was tall with long curly hair and wearing a black and red sweater. There was no direction of travel given by either victim.
