

Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Stations

The City of Davis maintains four locations with Electric Vehicle (EV) charging stations available for public use. The location of each charging station is listed below along with a description of what type of charger is available at each of the four stations.

There are two types of electric vehicles:

EV = Electric Vehicle

(may be driven on all streets and highways)

NEV = Neighborhood Electric Vehicle

(low speed EV's may be driven on streets posted under 35mph)

- **City Hall – 23 Russell Blvd**
1 - EV parking space with 208V Magne Charger
4 - NEV parking spaces with 110V duplex outlets
- **E Street Plaza – 220 E Street**
1 – EV space with one Magne Charger TCG2000
- **SP Train Depot – 840 Second Street**
2 – EV spaces, with two different types of charging connections. Charging connections as follows:
1-EV with 208V Magne Charger; 1-EV with 208V ICS2000 Charger
- **Mace Blvd Park n' Ride – behind corner of Mace Blvd and County Road 32A**
1 - NEV parking space with 110V duplex outlet

Other sites available for use, not maintained by the City are located at:

- **4th & G Parking Structure – 835 G Street** (entrance on 4th Street)
2 – EV spaces, with three different types of charging connections. Charging connections as follows:
1-EV with 208V Magne Charger; 1-EV with 208V ICS2000 Charger;
1 NEV with 110V duplex outlet
